Schaeffer's Racing Oil proves to be a top performer.

### The Story

Peacock Enterprises in Van Buren, Arkansas operates a 27 truck fleet throughout the United States. As enjoyment Raymond Peacock races on the weekend with a small block 388 Chevrolet engine. It develops about 600 HP and runs around 6500 RPM's. Raymond uses Schaeffer's #191 Racing Oil 20W-50 and changes every fifth night out. Recently, he was racing in the A Feature. **As Raymond was finishing the race, he looked down at his gauges and noticed that there wasn't any oil pressure.** When he reached the pits, his crew checked the pressure with a manual gauge as he revved the engine, - zero oil pressure. He was not sure how long the car ran full out in that condition.

**The crew took the oil pan off and found that the oil pickup tube had come off and was in the bottom of the pan. At the shop they replaced the oil pump and restarted the engine: 70# pressure came up immediately. There was no damage to the engine and they have run three races since that night. Macon Motorsports refreshed the engine after 1,500 laps at the end of the season. Pictures of the shaft, piston and bearings are shown below.**
