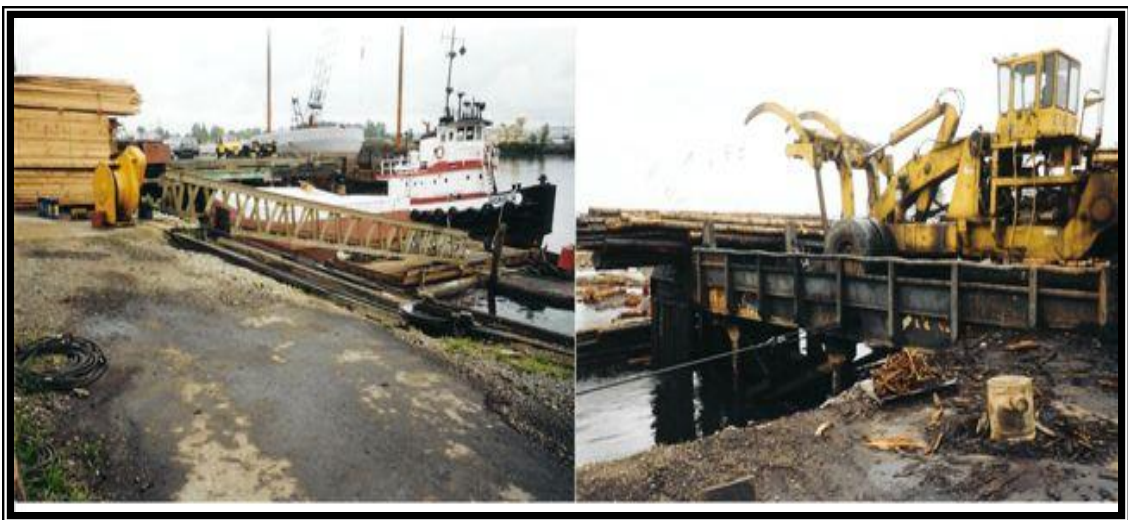

The Story

Manke Lumber Company has been in business since 1964. Today they process 160 million board feet a year.

The company uses a log lift to remove truck-size loads of logs out of Puget Sound. This lift is operated by an electric winch with a 1 ½" cable that has been known to break. The loads are about 36,000 pounds and the log lift loads approximately 100 loads within a 24-hour period – putting tremendous tension on the cable.

Manke Lumber has been using Schaeffer's #199 Silver Streak Wire Rope Lube for over six years. They apply it to the cable approximately once every two months with a paintbrush. Dave Fisher says that the company is very pleased with the extended life of this wire rope which they attribute to using Schaeffer's wire rope lube.
